LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE

Position Summary

Provides nursing care to patients in a clinical setting and in patient homes. Coordinates activities with primary care nurse, Primary Care Team members and community resources.

Permanent Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Assesses the health needs of patients under the supervision of the primary registered nurse.
- Evaluates the impact of the home environment on the health and safety of patients.
- Establishes plan of care jointly with medical doctor, primary care nurse, patient, and family.
- Observes patients, charts and reports changes in patients' conditions, such as adverse reactions to medication or treatment, and takes any necessary action.
- Administers prescribed medications, and notes times and amounts on patients' charts.
- Measures and records patients' vital signs as required.
- Provides basic patient care and treatments, such as wound care and other treatments as required.
- Works as part of a health care team to assess patient needs, plan and modify care and implement interventions.
- Utilizes community and agency resources as needed.
- Collaborates with Registered Nurse on all cases to ensure delivery of quality patient care.
- Assures accurate and timely documentation of care per company standards.
- Keeps abreast of all changes by attending team, full staff, mandatory and hoc meetings.

Requirements

- Graduate from a school of practical nursing that is accredited by the State of Massachusetts
- Minimum of 2 years clinical experience
- Must hold current LPN License to practice in Massachusetts
- Current CPR Certification
- Bilingual (Spanish) required
